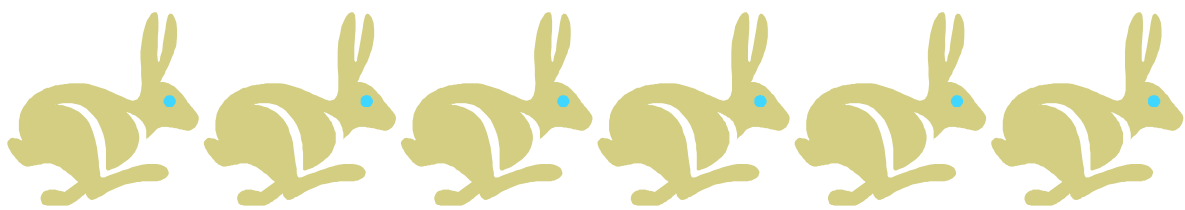

Under 8 League Rules

Under 8 'incrediball' League, Playing Conditions

Players must be born on or after 1st September 1999.

Matches will be played with an 'incrediball' (or equivalent soft ball if necessary) and protective equipment is not required. Due to the lightweight ball, a 16 yard pitch is preferable and a kwik cricket stump set with bails is acceptable if a pitch of 16 yards is not otherwise available (see also 'no-balls' below)

Players should preferably wear 'whites' but flexibility should be allowed for this entry-level beginners league.

Each side must provide an umpire and a scorer.

Umpires may agree to reasonable coaching and acting captaincy.

Matches will consist of 20 overs per side with both sides completing their allocation even if the side batting second overtakes the target score.

Sides will start with 200 runs and will consist of 10 players who will bat as 5 pairs facing 4 overs each. When a batsman is out, his side shall lose 4 runs and he shall swap ends with his partner, except off the last ball of an over: in other words, he should not face the next delivery.

Everyone other than the wicketkeeper (or the first wicketkeeper, if more than one is used) must bowl at least one over but no more than 3.

Wides and no-balls count as 2 runs, plus any runs or byes actually scored, with no extra ball bowled except during the final over of each innings when 6 legitimate balls must be bowled.

No-balls: if a fixture is played on a pitch longer than 16 yards (max 20 yards), the umpires should take a lenient view on the front foot rule as appropriate (e.g. on an 18 yard pitch, allow the ball provided the back foot is behind the popping crease in the delivery stride)

Nobody except the wicketkeeper may field closer than 11 yards from the batsman, except behind square on the off side. If available, an 11-yard ring should be marked with safe flat discs

In the event of a side fielding with less than 10 players, they will only receive 2 overs per player fielded. i.e. if they have 9 players, they receive only 18 overs with the 9th batsman receiving the odd 2 overs and a runner at the non-striker's end who cannot face any deliveries but can be run-out. If a side has only 8 players, they will receive 16 overs. The match must be conceded if a side has less than 8 players.

In the event of injury during the game, a fielding substitute can be used and the batting side is encouraged to offer one if the fielding side does not have a spare player of its own. For batting purposes, the injured batsman must be replaced by a runner who cannot take strike any time during the 4 overs faced by the 'live' batsman.

The side with the highest total after 20 overs each shall be the winner with the result a tie if the scores are level.

All League matches must be played in accordance with the fixture schedule produced by the League Fixture Secretary unless either side gives **at least 7 days** notice of any alteration. Any side unable to fulfil a fixture must concede the match unless at least 7 days notice is given and a mutually agreed re-scheduled date can be arranged (notifying the Fixture Secretary accordingly).

In the event of a match being abandoned due to the weather each side will receive 2 points with no League fixture being re-arranged unless both sides agree to a mutually acceptable date which must be no later than the date of the last scheduled league fixture plus 3 days.

League points shall be awarded as follows:-

- 4 points for a win
- 2 points for a tie or abandonment
- 1 point for a defeat
- 0 points for a concession

Sides finishing the season level on points shall be separated by their run differential, the higher positive number winning, calculated as runs scored minus runs against, based on the season's innings totals. If still level, the winner of the match between the two sides will determine the higher position.

Under 10 League Rules

Under-10 Playing Conditions

Players must be born on or after 1st September 1997.

Each side must provide an umpire and scorer.

Umpires may coach on the field but it should be kept to a minimum and for 'friendly advice' only.

All League matches must be played in accordance with the fixture schedule produced by the League Fixture Secretary unless either side gives **at least 7 days** notice of any alteration. Any side unable to fulfill a fixture must concede the match unless at least 7 days notice is given and a mutually agreed re-scheduled date can be arranged (notifying the Fixture Secretary accordingly).

Cup fixtures must be played on a mutually agreed date within the timescales indicated by the League Fixture Secretary with the home side offering at least 3 possible dates. In the event of difficulties obtaining their ground the home side may concede home advantage and switch the fixture to their opponents ground. Any disputes must be referred to the League Fixture Secretary.

In the event of a match being abandoned due to the weather each side will receive 2 points with no League fixture being re-arranged.

Cup ties must be rearranged to a mutually acceptable date which should be prior to the scheduled date of the next round.

Matches will consist of 20 overs per side with both sides completing their allocation even if the side batting second overtakes the target score.

Sides will start with 200 runs and will consist of 10 players who will bat as 5 pairs facing 4 overs each. When a batsman is out his side shall lose 4 runs and he must swap ends with his partner, except off of the last ball of an over, so that he does not face the next delivery.

Everyone other than the wicket-keeper, who may not be changed during the course of an innings except in the case of injury, must bowl at least 1 over but no more than 3.

Wides and no-balls count as 2 runs with no extra ball bowled except during the final over of each innings when 6 legitimate deliveries must be bowled. Any additional 'runs' scored will be added to the total.

No-balls - if a fixture is played on a 22-yard pitch the 2 umpires may agree prior to the start of the match to take a lenient view on the front foot rule allowing the bowler to overstep.

Nobody may field closer than 11 yards from the batsman except behind square on the off-side.

In the event of a side fielding less than 10 players they will only receive 2 overs per player fielded i.e. if they have 9 players they only receive 18 overs with the 'extra' batsman facing the odd 2 overs with a runner at the non-strikers end who may not face any deliveries but may be run out and if they only have 8 players they will receive 16 overs as 4 pairs of 4 overs each.

A side may not fulfill a fixture with less than 8 players and the match must be conceded.

In the event of injury during the game a fielding substitute may be used and we encourage the batting side to offer one if the fielding side does not have one of its own. For batting purposes the injured batsman must be replaced by a runner who shall not be able to take strike at any time during the 4 overs faced by the 'live' batsman.

The side with the highest total after their allotted overs (20, or any subsequent reduction due to not having a full side) shall be the winner with the result a tie if the scores are level, except in Cup matches when the result will be decided by the side with the highest score after their allotted overs minus 1, or if still level minus 2, minus 3 etc. until a result can be determined.

League points shall be awarded as follows:-

- 4 points for a win
- 2 points for a tie or abandonment
- 1 point for a defeat
- 0 points for a concession

Sides finishing the season level on points shall be separated by their run differential, the higher positive number winning, calculated as runs scored minus runs against, based on the season's innings totals. If still level, the winner of the match between the two sides will determine the higher position.

All players aged nine and above will need to ensure that they have a cricket box and suitable pants. Other equipment is provided by the club. We have limited supplies of helmets, pads and bats.

Under 13 League Rules

Under-13 Playing Conditions

Players must be born on or after 1st September 1994.

Each side must provide an umpire and scorer.

Umpires may coach on the field but it should be kept to a minimum and for “friendly advice” only. **It must not be used to organise the side !**

Each side will comprise 11 players and matches will consist of 20 overs per side.

Batsmen must retire on reaching 25 but may return when all other members of the side have batted. In the event that more than one batsman has retired during the course of the innings the batsman must return in the same order as they batted first i.e. if batsmen number 1 and 2 both retire then batsman number 1 must return before batsman number 2.

Bowlers may bowl a maximum of 3 overs each – **NB all players are not required to bowl.**

Wides and no-balls count as 2 runs with no extra ball bowled except during the final over of each innings when 6 legitimate deliveries must be bowled. Any additional ‘runs’ scored will be added to the total.

No-balls - when a fixture is played on a 22-yard pitch the 2 umpires may agree to take a lenient view on the front foot rule allowing the bowler to overstep by up to a yard.

Nobody may field closer than 11 yards from the batsman except behind square on the off-side.

All League fixtures must be played on Sunday mornings in accordance with the fixture schedule provided by the League Fixture Secretary.

Cup matches must be played on a mutually agreed date within the timescales indicated by the League Fixture Secretary with the home side offering at least 3 alternative dates. In the event of difficulties regarding use of their ground the side drawn at home may concede home advantage. Any disputes must be referred to the League Fixture Secretary.

In the event of abandonment no League fixture will be rearranged but Cup matches must be re-scheduled to a mutually acceptable date.

In the event that a side does not have a full compliment of 11 players their allotted overs will be reduced by 2 per player they are short, ie. A side with 10 players shall receive only 18 overs and any retired batsman may return after a tailender has batted for a second time as if the eleventh player.

If scores finish level the side losing fewer wickets shall be declared the winner, if the number of wickets lost is the same then the match will be a tie.

League points shall be awarded as follows:-

4 points for a win

2 points for a tie or abandonment

1 point for a defeat

0 points for a concession

Sides finishing level on points in the League shall be separated by virtue of the result of their match during the season. In the event of more than two sides being level the second tie-breaker will be calculated on net run rate in matches between the sides in the tie – net run rate is calculated as follows:

(Runs Scored / Wickets Lost) MINUS (Runs Against/Wickets Taken).

The League will be divided into divisions 1 and 2 based on the average points accumulated over the previous 3 seasons, the Clubs shall play each once in the first half of the season. At this point the bottom two sides in division 1 will be relegated and the top two sides in division 2 promoted, and the sides shall play each other once more. The points from the first half of the season will be carried forward to the second half of the season with the Champions being the side that finishes top of division 1 at the end of the season.

In the event that the Leagues have uneven numbers then the first division will always contain the extra side and at the half way point the sides promoted from Division 2 will have 2 points added to compensate for the game less played during the first half of the season and the two sides relegated from Division 1 will have 1 point removed from their totals to compensate for the additional game played in the first half of the season.
